WHAT IS THE DOOR TOOL / FOH TOOL?

We have 2 tools available to check in ticketholders to your event. They have slightly different layouts to suit your needs, depending on how many events/venues you are managing. Functionally, they both allow you to do the following:

- · Check in audience to your event
- View individual booking details such as access requirements
- Use external smartphone devices to scan tickets

The only difference is the Stopping Sales function which is only available through the door tool, which will be explained later in this guide.

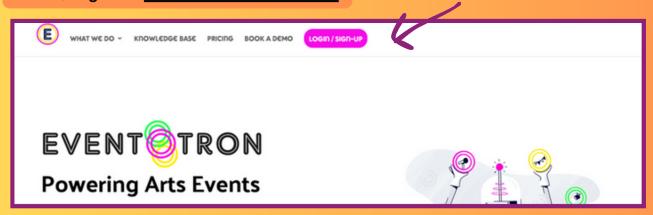
USING THE DOOR TOOL

The reason why the Door Tool is easier if you are only managing a few events is because you will need to go into each event individually to access the Door Tool.

1. LOGIN TO EVENTOTRON + OPEN DATES, TIMES AND PRICES

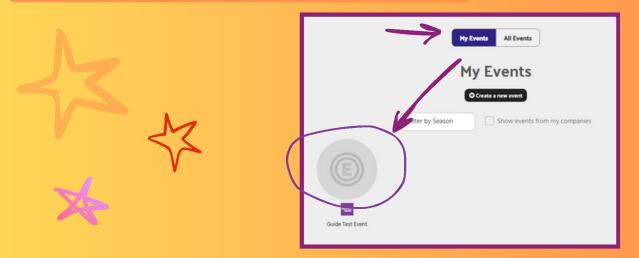
Using the same login as you used to register your event, login to www.eventotron.com



In the header, go to EVENTS

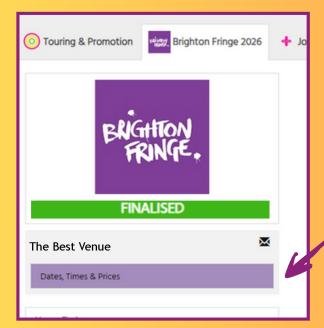


Go into 'My Events', and select the relevant Event



Select the current festival from the Event bar



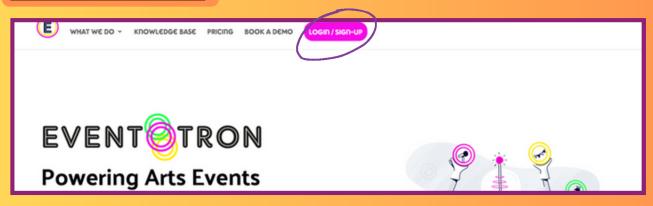


This will open your registration. Select 'Dates, Times and Prices' from the sidebar at the top.



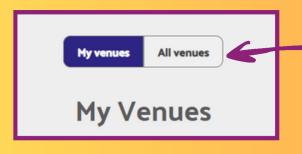
Venue Managers

Using the same login linked to your venue, login to www.eventotron.com



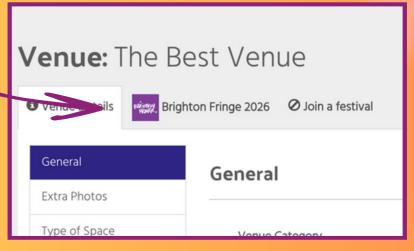
In the header, go to VENUES

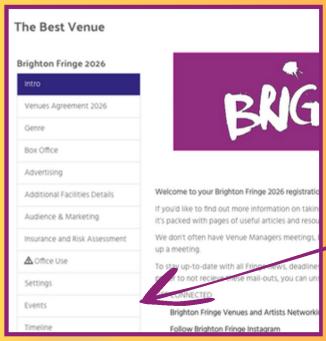




Select your venue from 'My Venues'

Select the current festival from the header





Select 'Events' from the left-hand sidebar in your venue settings

Select the event you want to access the door tool for





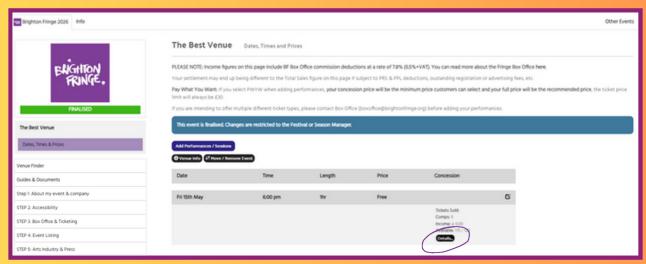
Select the current festival from the Event header



This will open the event registration. Select 'Dates, Times and Prices' from the sidebar at the top.

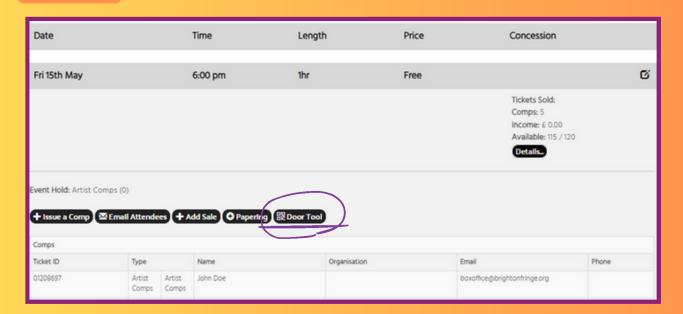
2. OPEN THE DOOR TOOL

Scroll to the performance you want to access the Door Tool for, and select the 'Details...' button to expand the options





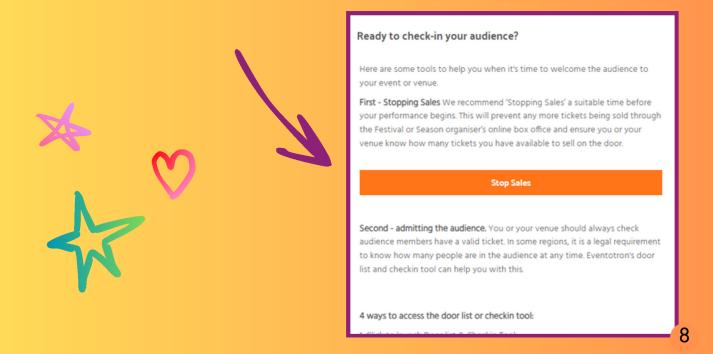
Select the Door Tool button from the options, which will launch the door tool!



4. STOPPING SALES

The option to Stop Sales becomes available 24 hours before your performance. This allows you to stop all sales through the Brighton Fringe Box Office, which is useful for knowing how many tickets you have left to sell on the door, and if you are opting to print your door list this will prevent any last minute sign ups.

To stop sales before the performance, click the orange button.



5. SELECT HOW TO ACCESS THE DOOR TOOL

Launching the Door Tool will bring up 4 options on how to access the tool, depending on your needs.

Download a CSV for other box offices or door tools. IMPORTANT NOTE for Venue Managers: If you are d performances, spaces and staff, you may prefer to u of House tool.	

6. READ AND ACCEPT THE PRIVACY POLICY

No matter which way you open the tool, you will be greeted with this privacy policy, which you must accept before continuing. This is because the information required to check in audience must only be used for admitting audience members to a performance. It is a criminal offence to use this information otherwise, as laid out in UK GDPR legislation.

You are now in the door tool and can check in your audiences!

You will see the customer name, ticket type and ticket ID, alongside any specified accessibility requirements.

Here are the options for checking in your audience:

- Activate the QR Reader on the device you have the door tool open on to scan the QR codes on audience members' E-Tickets.
- Search by audience member name or ticket ID and click the blue check in box next to their booking.
- Print the door list as a paper copy.

USING THE FRONT OF HOUSE (FOH) TOOL

The FOH Tool is accessed differently than to the door tool. You will need to set yourself and your team up as users, then go to eventotron.com/FOH. You will also have read the privacy policy and indicated your understanding in the Venues Agreement section of your registration.

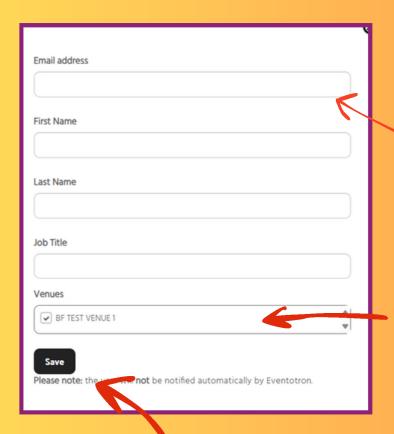
1. ADD USERS TO THE FOH TOOL

Go to your venue in Eventotron (see Step 1. of the Door Tool guide) and select 'Front of House Team' from the sidebar.



Once in this section, you will see any currently registered users. To add a new user, select the '+ Add User' button on the top right

Front of House Team Specify which users have access to the Front of House Tool. If users do not have an Eventotron account, they will be prompted to create one when they use the Front of House Tool Front of House users do not have access to the rest of your festival or season in Eventotron unless you have specifically added them to your company. Once you have granted them access, please direct your team members to eventotron.com/foh for access to the Front of House tool. Users may log in with their Eventotron accounts if they have them - otherwise they will be emailed a simple access code.



Now you can add in all the new user information. The most important part here is ensuring the email address is entered and correct.

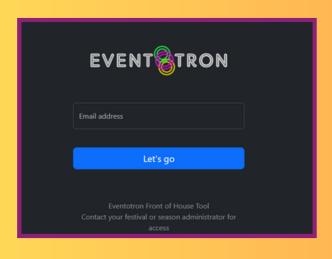
If you have multiple venues, more than one option will appear in the 'Venues' section, Make sure to tick all venues you would like the new user to access.

Click 'Save' once all the details have been entered

Please Note: when users are added to the FOH tool, they **will not** be automatically notified by Eventotron, and will instead need to log in through eventotron.com/foh.

2. ACCESS THE FOH TOOL

Go to Eventotron.com/Foh and enter in the email address you registered to the tool. Eventotron will provide instructions for creating an account of being emailed an access code in order to log in, so follow these steps as prompted.

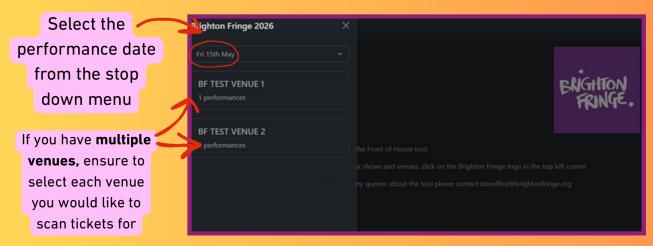




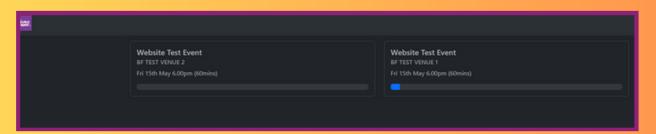
3. CHECK IN YOUR AUDIENCES

You will be greeted with a homescreen with a welcome message and the festival logo. Click on the small logo in the top left to open up the tool options.



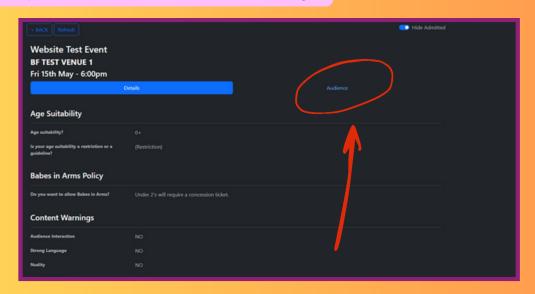


The events for the selected venue(s) and date will not pop up beneath the menu - click off of the sidebar menu to view



Select the performance you would like to check in audiences for

This will bring you to the details section, which will show you important event details such as Age Suitability, Babes in Arms policy and the performances' content warnings.



In order to check in your audience, you will need to select the 'Audience' tab



Here you will see a list of all bookings, along with any access requirements specified next to the booking name.

You can ask for the ticketholders name and check them in with the blue check in button, or click the QR code scanner icon in the top right to scan QR codes on your device

Hide Admitted

As outlined in your registration, customer details must only be used for the purpose of checking audiences into an event. It is a **criminal offence to use the audience information for any other purpose** including, but not limited to, personal communication, marketing or solicitation.
